What is the Pharmacy Partnership for Long Term (LTC) Program?

The program is a partnership between the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) and a select number of pharmacies around the country to administer the COVID-19 vaccine in nursing homes

HOW WILL USING THE PARTNERSHIP PHARMACIES BENEFIT NURSING HOMES?

- They will come to the homes to administer the vaccine to both staff and residents
- They will coordinate the “clinics” in the homes on vaccine days
- They have the equipment necessary to safely handle and prepare the Pfizer vaccine
 - As of today, the ANHA has been told the Pfizer vaccine has been chosen to be used in the first round of vaccinations in Alabama nursing homes
 - This vaccine requires extreme cold storage and the participating pharmacies have the necessary equipment to handle it effectively
- They offer support, provide guidance and answer questions about the vaccines on their company websites
- They will file all applicable governmental paperwork regarding vaccinations on behalf of the homes

The ANHA has developed materials for all nursing homes to use in educating their residents and staff about the vaccine

- Printed and digital materials will be sent in the next week to the attention of the administrator
- A website will be maintained at VaxxNow.com to educate residents, their sponsors and nursing home staff about the vaccine
- Since Pfizer vaccines will be administered in nursing homes initially, the materials cover Pfizer related information, but will be modified to include other vaccines as they are made available to nursing homes

3. Work with your pharmacies to ensure a smooth process on your "clinic" days
